Sub: Grant of Conditional Permission to Shri Gangadhar Shastri Gune Ayurved Mahavidyalaya, Vishrambaug, Dist.Ahmednagar-414001, Maharashtra with 63 seats (including EWS) in UG (BAMS) course for the academic session 2020-21 under section 13A/13C of the IMCC Act, 1970- reg.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer to the Ministry's letter No. L.14014/283/2019-EP (IM-1) dated 15.06.2019 related to admission matter for the academic year 2019-20, intimating certain requirements to be fulfilled by the college for consideration of permission for the academic session 2020-21.

2. Further, refer to the CCIM's letter No.Ref.3-3/2020-Ay. (5) dated 21.09.2020 forwarding therewith recommendation of the college to the Central Government based on thorough examination of the visitation report Part-I, indemnity bond, affidavit & latest details of teaching, non-teaching and hospital staff submitted by the college along with the assessment report, as the physical verification by conduction of inspection could not be carried out in view of present COVID-19 pandemic situation for the A.Y. 2020-21. On examining the same, it is found that, the college is not fulfilling the requirement related to Website as specified in sub-regulation (2) of regulation 9 of RMS, 2016 and therefore, an opportunity for Hearing/Compliance to update the website by 10.10.2020 was granted to the college under the provisions of IMCC Act, 1970.

3. The Compliance submitted by the college and recommendations & assessment report of the CCIM have been carefully examined in terms of Regulation 3 of the “Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016”, provisions under the IMCC Act, 1970, relevant regulations made thereunder and it is found that the College is fulfilling notified and approved criterion for granting Conditional Permission for UG (BAMS) course.

4. It has, therefore, been decided by the Central Government to grant Conditional Permission to Shri Gangadhar Shastri Gune Ayurved Mahavidyalaya, Vishrambaug, Dist.Ahmednagar-414001, Maharashtra for conducting 63 seats (including EWS) in UG (BAMS) course for the academic session 2020-21 under Section 13C/13A of the IMCC Act, 1970.

5. It is further informed that minimum of 15% of undergraduate of the permitted intake capacity of 63 UG (BAMS) seats shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quotas shall be conducted by the Central Government and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State. If any seats are not filled up in the Central Counseling, the same shall be transferred to the said Counseling Authority to admit students as per their rules/ reservation policies/norms. **The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the Central counseling for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.**
6. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under IMCC Act & Regulations made thereunder.
7. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Board of Governors, CCIM and the Central Government.
8. The following requirements should be fulfilled by the college by 31st December, 2020 to get permission for the session 2021-22:
- all the Requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016;
 - all the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) Amendment Regulations, 2016 (for Ayurveda); and
 - all the requirements under the provisions of the IMCC Act, 1970 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled *in toto*
9. The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college to CCIM under intimation to this Ministry. The CCIM will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled by means of an inspection and submit a report along with its assessment in this matter to the Ministry of AYUSH for considering the permission matter from the academic session 2021-22.
10. This issues with the approval of Competent Authority.
